

WHITES

CHARDONNAY

- Clos du Bois | North Coast** \$6.5 \$25
Medium bodied, boasting ripe pear, citrus and vanilla flavors. Rich, buttery texture, with complexity and depth.
- Toasted Head | California** \$21
Opening notes of pears, citrus, and apple blossoms, followed by flavors of lemon, coconut, hints of peach, pineapple and cinnamon.
- Wente 'Morning Fog' | Livermore Valley** \$33
Aromas and flavors of green apple and tropical fruits, balanced by subtle oak, cinnamon and vanilla from barrel aging. Delivers a medium-long, refreshing finish.
- Cuvaison | Napa Valley** \$40
Toasty oak, vanilla, hazelnut and fig on a wave of apricot and white peach. Dense and concentrated, luxurious floral and fruit notes.
- Kistler | Sonoma County** \$94
Chablis-like in its markings of white flowers and lime blossom with a chalk driven subtle core of fruit.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

- Kim Crawford | Marlborough** \$7 \$26
A crisp wine with intense aromas of gooseberry, passion fruit and citrus flavors. Great with salads and seafood.
- Simi Sauvignon Blanc | Sonoma** \$23
Zesty notes of tangerine, lime, and grapefruit—the palate has a long finish with a lingering impression of green citrus and stone fruit. Small amounts of Viognier and Semillon were blended in, creating a wine with extraordinary richness.

PINOT GRIGIO

- Ecco Domani | Italy** \$7 \$22
Notes of light citrus and delicate floral aromas with tropical fruit flavors. Medium-bodied, soft palate and a crisp, refreshing finish.
- Simply Naked | California** \$19
Crisp and refreshing with layers of lime and melon and aromas of peach, passion fruit, and hints of spice.
- Santa Margherita | Italy** \$42
A dry white wine with a clean, intense aroma and an appealing flavor of Golden Delicious apples.

LIGHTER WHITES

- BEX Riesling | Germany** \$7 \$22
Notes of mandarin orange blossom, green apple and honey suckle, with flavors of key lime pie, star fruit and lime zest.
- Piquitos "Little Kisses" Moscato | Spain** \$7 \$22
Lightly sweet, slightly pink and wonderfully effervescent, with aromas of rose petals and peaches.

REDS

PINOT NOIR

- Underwood | Oregon** \$7.5 \$26
Nicely balanced with raspberry fruit flavor showcasing classic Oregon style.
- Duck Pond | Willamette Valley** \$38
Brimming with Bing cherry, red fruits, and spice, giving way to a full-bodied mouthfeel.
- Castle Rock | Willamette Valley** \$23
Flavors of berries, cinnamon, black cherry, sweet vanilla oak, floral notes, with a velvety finish.
- Robert Mondavi Private Selection | Napa Valley** \$46
This Pinot Noir opens with the intense aromas of dark fruit, such as cherries and plums that echo on the palate.

MERLOT & MALBEC

- Toad Hollow Merlot | Russian River** \$6.5 \$25
Black cherry and blueberry with a hint of baking spice and chocolate. Luxurious texture.
- Sebastiani Merlot | Sonoma County** \$29
Plum and blackberry flavors mixed with chocolate and toasted coffee notes and a ruby red color.
- The Velvet Devil Merlot | Washington** \$22
Classic aromas of dark cherries, cedar, pipe tobacco. Anise, stone and cherry blossoms. Super smooth, a true Velvet Devil.
- Misterio Malbec | Mendoza** \$22
Soft, fresh, and full-bodied with notes of red berries, plum, spice, black pepper and mint.
- Broquel Malbec | Mendoza** \$29
Complex notes of currant, berries and spice. Fruit sourced from elevations average 2500 feet create an environment perfectly suited for achieving maximum ripeness with little human interference.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- Three Blind Moose | California** \$7 \$22
A good medium bodied wine, bright and vibrant with tastes of dark berry, plum, chocolate, clove and spice.
- Estancia | Paso Robles** \$29
Black currant, plum and blackberry flavors with mineral and cedary oak notes. Mocha tones slide through the finish.
- Wayne Gretzky Estate No. 99 | Sonoma County** \$33
Rich blackberry fruit, excellent balance and complexity from French and American oak barrels.
- Napa Cellars | Napa Valley** \$38
Elegant aromas of plum and dark fruit alongside flavors of black and red fruits, with a hint of cinnamon and tobacco, full-bodied.
- Dusted Valley | Columbia Valley** \$44
This is just a spectacular Cabernet from the Columbia Valley. Boasting an inviting nose, muscular tannins, lingering finish.

REDS

RED BLENDS

Double Decker Red | Central Coast \$23

A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah and Barbera. Mouth-filling flavors of blackberry, black cherry and plum.

Apothic Red | California \$24

Crafted from a blend of Zinfandel, Syrah, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, this decadent blend is framed by hints of black cherry, vanilla, and mocha.

Franciscan Oakville Magnificat | Napa Valley \$78

A Bordeaux-style blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petite Verdot and Malbec creates a complex mélange of cassis, plum, and mocha. Aromas of peppercorn, black olive, sage, and tobacco. Elegant and rich with cherry and blackberry fruit followed by fine, supple tannins and a velvety mouthfeel. Notes of cocoa, crème de cassis, and black truffle; delicious roundness and texture, seamless finish.

OTHER ROUGES & ROGUES

Seven Deadly Zins | California \$36

This wine is made with seven different grapes. It's not just another bottle with a quirky name...this wine is good.

Four Vines "Biker" Zinfandel | Paso Robles \$29

The Bad Boy of Zin, delivers flavors of plums, boysenberries and cherries with a smoky char to balance the fruit. Biker rocks!

Boom Boom Syrah | Columbia Valley \$28

Aromas of fresh herbs and wet earth. Rich black cherry and tobacco finishing with hints of lavender. An explosive dark cherry bomb!

Straccali Chianti | Tuscany, Italy \$22

Ruby red with intense and persistent violet tones.

Vin de table Blanc | France

A blend of Chardonnay, Ugni Blanc and Muscadelle, softly balanced with a delicate and refreshing taste

Vin de table Rouge | France

A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, ripe fruit flavors with a dry, round body and low tannins.

Barefoot White Zinfandel | California

Flavors of peach, strawberry, pear and pineapple, deliciously sweet.

SPARKLING

William Wycliff Brut | California \$12

Fruity with a touch of strawberry, crisp and finished on the upswing.

Lunetta Prosecco | Trentino \$6.5 \$25

Enticing aromas of apple and peach give way to a palate that is refreshing and harmonious, with crisp flavors and a clean finish.

Luccio Moscato d'Asti | Veneto \$22

Fresh bright citrus aromas with floral hints. Sweet delicate flavors of tangerine and honey with soft frizzante bubbles.

AFTER DINNER

Inniskillin Vidal Ice Wine | Canada [2oz] \$12

Billowing with ripe peaches and apricots on the nose combined with delicious overtones of marmalade and candied brown sugar. Perfect on its own as dessert, or an excellent match to fresh fruit, rich paté or fine blue-veined and cream based cheeses.

Vikre Boreal Juniper Gin | Duluth MN \$6.5

Piney juniper aromas intermingle with distinctly floral and citrusy aromas like lemon zest and rhubarb. Flavors of rhubarb, orange, and cardamom are underlain by the subtle spice of pink peppercorns.

Øvrevann Aquavit | Duluth MN \$6.5

Øvrevann, Norwegian for "Upper Lake," aquavit is the original Scandinavian distilled spirit. Infused with caraway and cardamom, fundamental spices in Scandinavian cuisine. An early Norwegian version was aged in oak barrels on ocean voyages to Australia. According to Norwegian lore, t'was something magic about the trips across the equator that made it so delicious. Great served ice cold.

Remy Martin V. S. Petite Champagne Cognac \$6.5

A distinct round smooth cognac with subtle aromas.

Far North Alander Spiced Rum | Minnesota \$6.5

The name Ålander (\OH•LAN•DER\) is a nod to the Åland islands, an archipelago of 6,500 islands between Sweden and Finland in the northern Baltic. Alander is made in the Red River Valley, using sugar cane and spiced with whole bean vanilla, cinnamon, allspice and cloves. A hint of espresso lends a surprising depth of flavor.

Courvoisier \$6.5

Crafted with blends heralding from the Fins Bois and a petite Champagne crus.

Dow Ruby Port \$6.5

Bright raspberry and cherry flavors marry well with cocoa powder and mineral notes with a drier finish.
